VB-MAPP

Mark Sundberg, co-author of the ABLLS-R has now developed the VB-MAPP (The Verbal Behavior Milestones Assessment and Placement Program). This is a criterion-referenced assessment tool, curriculum guide, and skill tracking system that is designed for children with autism, and other individuals who demonstrate language delays. The VB-MAPP is based on B.F. Skinner's (1957) analysis of verbal behavior, established developmental milestones, and research from the field of behavior analysis. This workshop will provide a brief overview of the assessment that identifies a child's strengths and weaknesses, as well as barriers that may be impeding learning.
